

Commands/Los mandatos

Commands are use to tell somebody **DO** or **DON'T!**

Tú commands are directed toward 'you' – ONE person in a familiar/informal setting.

+ Affirmative/ **DO**

1. **form the tú (present tense)**
2. **drop the 's'**

irregulars:

decir - di	poner - pon
ir - ve	tener - ten
ser - sé	venir - ven
hacer - haz	salir - sal

*any pronouon is attached to the
AFFIRMATIVE with an accent on the
3rd syllable from the end
(levántate = get up)

- Negative/ **DON'T**

1. **form the yo (present tense)**
2. **drop the 'o'**
3. **add the opposite tú ending**
(AR – es)
(ER/IR – as)

irregulars:

ser – no seas
ir – no vayas
dar – no des
estar – no estés

*any pronoun is BEFORE the
NEGATIVE command after NO

(no te levantes)

CAR – c-qu (tocar) ¡No toques el piano!
GAR – g-gu (llegar) ¡No llegues tarde!
ZAR – z-c (empezar) ¡No empieces ahora!
