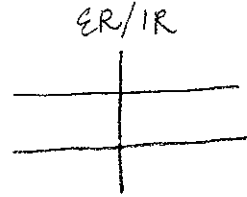
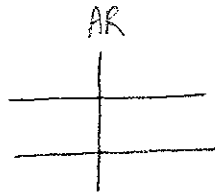


VERBS WITH "QUIRKS" WILL USE REGULAR ENDINGS IN THE PRETERITE
